- Veterans from the Portuguese Armed Forces
- Spanish Reservists

- Members from the National Security Forces

DOCUMENTATION:

- Spanish Reservists: TIM, certificate of having completed the pre-trial phase. - Foreign Reservists: Certificate of belonging to a recognized reservist association by AESOR or CIOR (except for Portuguese reservists)
- Veterans: Certificate of approval issued by that association to which belongs
- Cadets: Paternal authorization and certificate of acknowledgement and military competencies valuation from the CJC
- Everybody: ID and medical assistance insurance

POSTS: 250 people

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

- As part of a competition patrol (4 members)
- As a member of a «non competition» patrol
- As a collaborator in pitch controls or being in charge of events

ACCOMODATION: Camping inside a hostel

TRAVELS: Chargeable to the participants.

MATERIAL. - The organization forecasts to have at its disposal of the necessary material for the development of most of the events: ropes and harnesses, bows and arrows, vehicles for support, link radios between different control areas and an ambulance

PERSONAL EQUIPMENT.

- All participants coming to the raid would have been in possession of mountain special shoes, a small backpack (of the battle kind) and a balaclava; a multipurpose knife and cutlery; a water bottle with a pot; a swimming dress and a towel; special gloves for rappel dropping; a torch, paper, a pencil and a pen and a sleeping bag. It is advisable to carry a track suit, a dry change of clothes (including shoes), warm and rain garments.

PATROL TEAM.

- Patrols must be in possession of: first aid kits and compass.
- The organization must provide a topographical plan of the area.

UNIFORMS. - Along the raid, official and actual battle uniforms of the belonged section or army. No coats of arms of different unities or sections, except professional members.

INSURANCES.

Advisable insurance treats and of accidents for any modality of national participation.
Indispensable insurance treats and of accidents for any modality of international participation.
